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MISSION

Grupo Artevino's mission is the production of quality wines from native varieties, from plots located in the most emblematic areas in the main Spanish origin appellations, destined for gastronomy and delicatessen shop.

HISTORY

Artevino's origins are closely linked to the Antón family, who founded Bodegas Izadi in the heart of Rioja Alavesa in 1987. From the very beginning, Bodegas Izadi set out to produce Rioja wines of exceptional quality with a modern approach while remaining firmly rooted in tradition. Working with old vines, naturally low yields, and the almost artisanal dedication of local winegrowers, the winery has always sought to express the unique character of this privileged area within the Rioja DOCa. The Antón family's deep roots in the hospitality industry and extensive knowledge of fine dining enabled Bodegas Izadi to establish itself quickly within the premium wine segment through a distinctive philosophy of both winemaking and commercialization.

MILESTONES

1987

At just 37 years old, renowned restaurateur Gonzalo Antón, owner of the iconic Zaldiaran Restaurant in the Basque Country, founded Bodegas Izadi, bringing together his two greatest passions: wine and gastronomy.

1993

Bodegas Izadi opened its doors to visitors in Villabuena de Álava, becoming one of Spain's pioneering wineries to offer its own restaurant, hotel, and guided tours. The winery also hosted several events during the groundbreaking Vitoria Congress on Signature Cuisine.

2000

Lalo Antón, son of the founder, joined the company, ushering in a new era of international expansion, new distribution channels, and continued growth.

2005

The launch of Orben in Rioja completed a period of expansion that had already included the acquisition of Finca Villacreces (2003) and Vetus (2004). Since then, Artevino has brought together four wineries across Rioja, Ribera del Duero, and Toro.

2010

As Izadi approached its 25th anniversary, it was named one of the 100 Best Wineries in the World by the American magazine Wine & Spirits.

2012

Finca Villacreces gained international recognition thanks to Pruno, which Robert Parker's The Wine Advocate described as the best Spanish wine ever rated under \$20.

2017

With the acquisition of Pinos Claros, located in Ribera del Duero's prestigious Golden Mile, Artevino expanded its estate vineyards to 275 hectares, 70% of which are organically farmed.

2019

The prestigious Wine Spectator Top 100 ranked Orben as Spain's Wine of the Year, placing it among the 15 highest-rated wines in the world.

2021

Artevino's commitment to sustainability and respect for origin led all of its wineries to become certified under the Sustainable Wineries for Climate Protection program. Selección tinta e Izadi Selección blanco.

2025

Izadi was selected as the Official Wine of the Michelin Guide Ceremony for Great Britain and Ireland, with both Izadi Selección Red and Izadi Selección White served throughout the event.

Finca VILLACRECES

The Hidden Jewel of the Golden Mile.

Villacreces is an exclusive estate located in the heart of Ribera del Duero's Golden Mile, home to some of the region's most iconic wines.

It is surrounded by a centuries-old pine forest and lies on a meander of the Duero River, creating a rich ecosystem that embraces the estate's different vineyard parcels.

The earliest records of Villacreces date back to a settlement of Cistercian monks in the 13th century.



VETUS

Where History, the Land and People Meet.

Vetus is about pushing boundaries while respecting and admiring the land where its wines are born.

Vetus challenges convention in search of the unique character of every variety and every vine. From its 20-hectare estate in Toro, the winery produces fresh, approachable wines that offer a new interpretation of the region's viticulture and native grape varieties.

Orben is Artevino's boutique project.

It reinterprets Rioja through old-vine micro-plots planted at the highest elevations of Rioja Alavesa, around Laguardia.

Climate, geography and grape varieties come together to produce small batches of highly distinctive wines.

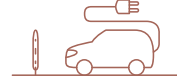

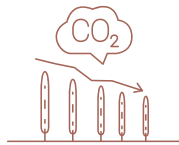
1- RENEWABLE ENERGY

Actions to protect and restore local biodiversity.



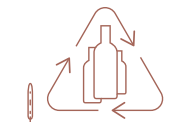
7- VINEYARD ADAPTATION

10% reduction in the amount of glass used per liter of bottled wine.



10- CERTIFICATIONS
